Corrugated Cardboard

Paperboard

Example: cereal boxes, paperboard egg cartons, and all paper food boxes that you put into your cupboard

Junk Mail (paperboard and junk mail go together)

Newspaper

Magazines (newspaper and magazines go together)

Office paper

Notebooks

Stationary

Computer paper

Paperback books

Glass food containers

Plastics:

- #1 clear bottles (with screw tops) -Example: Wesson oil, ketchup, mayonnaise
- #1 green plastic bottles -Example: olive oil
- #1LT blue -Example: big water container
- #2 colored plastic -Example: laundry detergent
- #2 opaque natural -Example: milk jugs
- #3 plastic containers (check the bottom for the number)
- #4 plastic containers (check the bottom for the number)
- #5 plastic containers (check the bottom for the number)
- #6 plastic containers (check the bottom for the number)
- #7 plastic containers (check the bottom for the number)

Steel cans

Aluminum cans

Containers :

Glass containers: please rinse clean and remove non-glass lids and rings. (labels are allowed) Non-container glass such as mirrors, windows, windshields, light bulbs, drinking glasses or ceramics go to the demolition container.

Plastic containers #1 through #7

Please rinse clean, labels are okay. Clear bottles, also opaque milk jugs, brittle tubs (yogurt, sour cream, or cottage cheese containers), water jugs and soap bottles, NO plastic bags, or wraps, styrofoam, plastic utensils or drinking glasses. Check the bottom for a Recycling Symbol.

Do not recycle these items:

(Throw these in your trash.)

- Styrofoam of any kind
- Frozen Food Containers (if it can go in your refrigerator or freezer, it is trash)
- Soda and beer containers (if it is made out of paper and can go in the refrigerator, it is trash)
- Any packaging material
- Plastic bags
- Plastic wrap
- Bubble wrap
- Packing peanuts
- Paper plates
- Tissue
- Paper towels
- Plastic straws
- Plastic utensils
- #1 plastic containers (example: containers that contain salad material, check the bottom for the number)

When recycling paper products:

Newspapers and magazines

Regular or colored, Newsprint including glossy paper and inserts go together.

Junk Mail:

Please keep junk mail separate from magazines & newspapers.

Other types of paper:

Corrugated cardboard, pasteboard, pizza boxes and paper beverage containers, bond paper, stationary, envelopes, computer paper, shredded paper, carbonless paper, notebooks, paper bags, file folders, cover stock.

- Remove any plastic wrappings or styrofoam inserts of any kind.
- NO frozen food containers of any kind.

When recycling containers,

Rinse out all plastic, glass and metal containers
